Students have the opportunity to **win prizes** for most minutes read per grade; additionally, the primary and secondary classes with the highest percentage of students participating will **win a class party/prize**. 100% of the money raised will be used to purchase new books for classrooms and guided reading.

We are so proud of our Edison students’ hard work, determination and dedication to their education!!

## Help Us With Traffic and Parking

In order to make sure that all students are safe and accounted for at all times, especially during drop-off and pick-up times, kindergarten students are dropped off/picked up on the southwest side of the building on Quitman Street and 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students are dropped off/picked up on the playground on the east side of the building.

We are requesting that ALL parents please follow traffic laws. Please support us by:

- Dropping your students off at school between 8:30 and 8:40. Supervision begins at 8:30 and the students line up ON THE PLAYGROUND to enter the building at 8:40 AM;
- Not parking in front of driveways;
- Not stopping in the middle of the street;
- Not parking in the school bus zone - on the south-east side of the school on Perry Street;
- Not parking on the north-west side of the street on Perry Street – this is loading/unloading or passenger pick up only;
- Not parking in the Edison parking lot (there is only enough space for staff);
- Not parking in the Kiss and Go/Greet and Get lane in the parking lot;
- Dropping your students off on Edison’s side of the street so they do not have to cross the street.

We encourage parents to drop off their 1st-5th grader at the **Kiss and Go** lane in the parking lot between 8:30 and 8:40. Also, if parents would like to sign up to participate in the **Greet and Get** lane to pick up their students in the parking lot at 3:35, please sign up in the office.

**Due to continued complaints, the Denver Police/DPS security will be giving tickets.** Please respect our neighbors and keep our kids safe around the school.

## Inside Days

With the weather getting cold and snow on its way, please be aware of the inside day policies at Edison. We really believe that students need to get outside and run around at the lunch hour. Unless it is below 20 degrees, very windy or very wet, students will go outside for recess. Please make sure your children dress accordingly every day. If students are inside for recess, they will have an opportunity to watch a movie, play board games or play calm games in the gym.

## Weather Delays and Closures

Since winter is now upon us, we want to make sure that parents understand the DPS/Edison Weather Delay and Closure policies.

**Weather Delay Schedule for Identified Schools:** In the event of adverse weather conditions that would impede the Transportation Department's ability to safely access students, a "**Weather Delay Schedule for Identified Schools**" will be implemented beginning this school year. The goal for this delay schedule is to provide buses/students an additional 60 minutes to access schools that start at 8:30 a.m. or later. If DPS has a **Weather Delay, school will begin at Edison for ALL students at 9:40 AM**. Morning buses will begin pickups at bus stops 1 hour later than the normal pick up time. Kaleidoscope will provide day care for students from 6:30 AM until 9:40 AM when school starts. Breakfast will still be served to students as they arrive to school.

**School Closing:** If schools are to be closed due to weather conditions, the district is committed to making a decision as early as possible. The decision to close is made by the Superintendent based on information provided by representatives from transportation agencies, the weather bureau, city and county law enforcement and DPS Transportation. If school is cancelled, this information will be communicated in the following ways: local television and radio stations, [dpsk12.org](http://dpsk12.org), the district's [Facebook](#) and [Twitter](#) pages.

**Severe Weather During School Day:** DPS will closely monitor severe weather conditions and forecasts throughout the day to ensure student safety. Should severe weather begin during the school day, bus routes will run in the same order as normally followed in the afternoon. Depending on conditions, arrival times at home may be delayed. You can reach the district transportation department at 720.423.4624 for your student's bus arrival time any time it's late. After-school activities (athletic events, enrichment programs, Kaleidoscope, etc.) may be modified or cancelled as a result of the weather conditions. Edison will send IC messages to communicate school closures during the school day.

## Parent Portal

DPS has an online Parent/Student Portal to make it easier to track a student's progress and plan for their future. Students can log into the Parent/Student Portal to see if they have all their assignments handed in. Parents can log into the Parent/Student Portal to check on their child's grades, attendance and test results. If you do not have a Parent Portal account, look for the flyer in this week's Thursday folder with details of how to sign up.
