

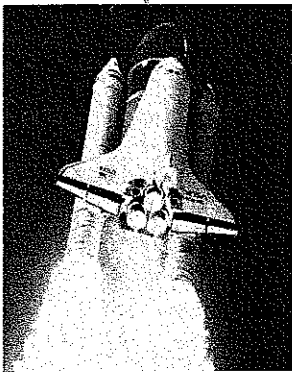


Space Adventure Enrichment Programs
